

#### ARCHITECT FOR EARTH

Since setting up his architectural practice Eco Design Architects in 1998, Andy Horn (pictured left) has become one of South Africa's leading architects in the areas of sustainability and ecodesign. The private and commercial buildings he's been involved in include structures for Eskom. Mondi Timbers and the Greenhouse Project in Jo'burg's CBD. Andy also lectures at the University of Cape Town on environmental architecture. All his projects adhere to the six principles he set out in the Manifesto for Green Architecture (presented at SA's first conference on Sustainability in the Built Environment in 1998). His work is therefore always holistic, non-polluting and respectful of the land and its resources, while at the same time promoting social, economic and cultural upliftment. As part of the company's social ethos, he and his team have also developed a series of how-to documents, available for between R25 and R300 from the website, on cost-effective housing using sustainable architecture.
